MISSION

The International Partnership Ministry Team of Pittsburgh Presbytery exists in order to help strengthen and encourage the church for faithful and fruitful discipleship in Pittsburgh Presbytery, the Synod of Blantyre, the South Sudan Presbyterian Evangelical Church and beyond. Specifically, this ministry team is charged with coordinating the relationship between the ecclesial bodies known as Pittsburgh Presbytery (Presbyterian Church USA), the Synod of Blantyre (Church of Central Africa: Presbyterian), and the South Sudan Presbyterian Evangelical Church as well as individual congregations within those expressions of the church.

SHARING GIFTS

Each party in this Partnership has gifts which, when shared with the others, will enrich the life and witness of the others. Second Corinthians 8:13-15 is one key to understanding this. We in Pittsburgh stand in need of the African Church's gift of joy, faith, love, music, simplicity, and Spirit. The gifts we offer our partners include administration, money, music, love, faith, and Spirit. The gospel calls us to build each other up — to be mutually encouraged by each other's faith.

In a quote attributed to an Australian Aboriginal woman, this idea is spoken well: "If you have come to help me, you are wasting your time. But if you have come because your liberation is bound up in mine, then let us work together." Our liberation and wholeness in Christ is bound up with those in Malawi and South Sudan and with people throughout the world, including our own neighborhoods here in Pittsburgh.

ROOFING

When the Good News spreads and the kingdom of God expands, villages build local prayer houses and churches. These building provide a place to teach the word of God and provide a sense of community. Residents can typically find the means to construct most of the church building, but struggle with the resources necessary to erect a roof. Your gift will enable a new village church to purchase expensive iron sheets and timber for a roof to provide shelter for their congregation.

DISASTER RELIEF

The African countries where our partners live have an infrastructure that is vulnerable to frequent droughts and flooding. When disaster strikes, it causes food shortages and lack of clean water, medical supplies and other basic life essentials. Your gift will enable our partner churches to respond to the critical needs of the communities they serve.

THEOLOGICAL EDUCATION

Our international partners, including Malawi and South Sudan, struggle to provide appropriate education for those who are eager to respond to God's calling to serve through the church. Your participation in this ministry will help provide funding for students at the Zomba

Theological College and the Nile Theological College in ways that enlarge the church's capacity for ministry. Gifts may be directed toward general scholarship assistance or specific programs (i.e., three-week intensives, etc.) in either country. We are not in a position, however, to guarantee funding for particular individuals as we are specific institutions.

MEDICAL

Since 1991 the International Partnership Ministry Team has shared in the historic commitment to comprehensive care. In Malawi, that has meant offering congregations the ability to "sponsor a bed" for a year at the Mulanje Mission Hospital. Churches in the Pittsburgh Presbytery can help provide low-cost, high-quality care to the underserved populations in rural Malawi by sponsoring a bed or donating to the general hospital budget.

DEVELOPMENT

From time to time our partners request funds for specific projects. For instance, a rural congregation may want to develop a community irrigation scheme to help raise the quality of life for the entire neighborhood. In another instance, a group of churches sought to purchase a vehicle to help bring produce to market in a way that encouraged local farmers to grow high-quality food. If your partner congregation has a particular vision, please encourage them to talk with their own denominational leadership about using this aspect of the Storehouse to help congregations share in the excitement of new projects.
